Dear Clients, Residents and Families:

As of February 4th, clients, residents, and staff members at Chippewa Manor Nursing & Rehab received the second dose of the coronavirus vaccine. Residents and staff at Chippewa Manor Residential Living have received their first dose and will have the second administered on March 2nd. This is an important step in our ongoing effort to keep our campus safe for all who live, rehab, and work here.

Vaccination is a giant step forward and we are both grateful and encouraged by this progress. At this point, state and local health officials have not issued any immediate recommendations for re-opening senior care facilities. It is likely to be several weeks until the majority of citizens in our area are able to receive the complete cycle of the coronavirus vaccine. However, with infection rates and positivity tests beginning to drop below 10 percent in our county, we appear to be heading in the right direction. If this trend continues, it should help set the stage for some form of visitation allowances in both of our campus settings. We will keep you posted as information becomes available.
